- Who:** United Church Youth ages 12-15 (Grades 7-9)
- What:** 3 day residential event to explore and experience being part of the church through games, music, discussion, and worship
- When:** May 27 – 30, 2010
- Where:** Mt. Allison University, Sackville, NB
- Cost:** \$225.00 – includes meals, accommodations, t-shirt

How to apply:

1. Complete the attached application form and give it to your minister or mail it to your Presbytery's Christian Life & Growth rep **BEFORE** March 1, 2010 (names and addresses on the other side of this sheet). You are asked to send a \$25 deposit (made payable to Maritime Conference Fund) with your application.
2. We hope to accept 120 youth this year. You will know by May 15th if you are accepted.
3. If you are selected to attend, the Intermediates at Conference (IAC) planning team will send you a letter with more information, including what to bring, where to meet, and contact numbers.

Parents: IAC offers young teens a chance to meet other youth their age to talk about what's important to them, to learn about the wider church, and to explore issues facing the church and youth today. They will also participate in portions of the Annual General Meeting of Maritime Conference. Participants at IAC are supervised at all times by screened and trained youth leaders and adults.

IAC has a "no cell phone use policy." Cell phones can only be used to call home if required. Emergency contact number for programme leaders will be provided. If participants bring cell phones they will be kept safe by a leader while participants are at IAC 2010.

Your youth(s) will be participating in many programs at IAC during the Maritime Conference weekend. In consideration that photographs and/or videos may be taken during any or all of the activities, we would like to inform you this may happen and that IAC youth and the planning team may take photos or video in connection with any and all promotional materials connected to the program. Participating youth may post pictures on Facebook. If you have a concern here, IAC planning team ask that you send an email or phone and we will discuss options with you, including the possibility of storing cameras in a safe place during IAC weekend and making every attempt to ensure pictures will not be taken.
